## Coverage for the Gallery *(continued)*

The Board approved expanding the Gallery hours as follows:

**Weekends:** Sat. 10-5; Sun. 12-4 pm: 5/21/11-7/3/11

**Summer** Tues.-Fri. 1-5pm: 7/5/11-9/4-2011

**Weeks:** Sat. 10-5 & Sun. 12-4 pm: 7/5/11-9/4/11  
*7/5 to 8/31*

3<sup>rd</sup> Fridays 5-9pm: 7/15/11 & 8/19/11

**Fall**

**Weekends:** Sat. 10-5; Sun. 12-4 pm 10/2/2011 Closing

Due to the increased hours the Gallery will be open, the Board voted to provide an incentive for artists who display their work in the Gallery to help insure that all the hours will be covered.

Artists signing the 2011 Consignment Agreement must volunteer for one, 4-hour shift per season or pay \$25. Artists who display their work and do not work or arrange substitute coverage for themselves will be charged the \$25. If enough money is in that fund at season's end, we will have a thank-you party for the volunteers who helped.

Of course, artists are encouraged to volunteer their time to ensure that the Gallery will be open to the public the maximum number of hours this season.

A sign-up sheet will be available during the "Intake of Art" June 5th and 6th. But, if you are interested in a special day of the week or weekend, contact Cloirse Mancini now, and save your date(s) early!

Note: Anyone working a 4-hour shift on a Saturday will get credit for 8-hours.

Also, members who sell their artwork in the gallery and gift shop have the added benefit of keeping more of the profits from the sale of their artwork:

Volunteer two 4hr/shifts a month, keep 80% of the sale

Volunteer one 4hr/shift a month, keep 70% of the sale

Volunteer 0 hours, keep 60% of the sale.

## New Artwork for the Season

New artwork will be accepted after the Art Show on **Sunday, June 5th from 4-6PM** and **Monday, June 6th from 5-7PM.**

Each member may have up to three (3) original pieces (that will fit on one hanger), and 10 prints. All original artwork hung in the gallery **MUST have a wire hanger** on the back of each frame. Original artwork will be hung in the first floor galleries and foyer. Prints, cards, jewelry and crafts will be in the gift shop. Prints may be unframed and go in display bins or may hang from the wall if wired and space allows. Artists will draw (first come, first served) for the location of their artwork, either in the main gallery, the foyer, or the gallery off of the gift shop. Artists are encouraged to change artwork from month to month and replace when artwork is sold. The season ends October 2, 2011
